These are the annual showcases for music award holders at Epsom College. All of them perform solo items on their main instruments and the resulting high standard always produces entertaining evenings.

Tuesday 4th October Big School Preparatory Schools' Music Festival

Many children from local preparatory schools come to Epsom College to enjoy learning songs and singing them together, this year on the theme of "Family". After rehearsing during the day they present their work in an informal concert at 4pm. *This event is not ticketed but the concert is open to parents and friends.*

Thursday 6th October 2pm Sports Hall Inter-House Choral Competition

All Houses keenly contest this ever-popular event, one of the oldest competitions in the school, each presenting a unison song, an unaccompanied part-song, and a soloist. Members of the audience can only enter or leave the hall between the programmes of each House, which start every 15 minutes, with the adjudication following at 5.30pm. *This event is not ticketed but is open to parents and friends.*

Wednesday 19th October 5.30pm Salisbury Cathedral Chapel Choir to sing Evensong

Chapel Choir have a rare opportunity to once again sing Evensong in this magnificent Cathedral. The service is open to the general public (not ticketed) and will include music by Neary and Nares.

Thursday 10th November 7.30pm Big School Remembrance Concert

It is a great privilege to welcome back a team of outstanding musicians to Epsom College for this special Remembrance Concert. Internationally acclaimed pianist and broadcaster David Owen Norris will be joined by singer Mark Wilde, and 'cellist Joseph Spooner, for an evening of music composed in or about the First World War. The concert will also include music specially composed for the occasion by pupils. This should be a moving, exciting and memorable event.

Thursday 17th November 7.30pm Big School A Concert given by M4 pupils

This is the first opportunity for the talented musicians who have joined the school this term to display their musical skills in an informal concert of solos and ensembles.

Thursday 1st December 7.30pm Big School An Ensembles Concert

A spectacular evening of ensemble music-making that will include the Big Band, Clarinet Ensemble, Downs Singers, Epsom Voices, Flute Ensemble, Orchestra, Percussion Ensemble, Samba Band, Sax Ensemble, and other groups in a celebration of music at Epsom College.

Thursday 15th December 4.30pm Chapel A Service of Nine Lessons with Carols

Chapel Choir will lead the worship in the final services of term, which follow the traditional format of nine lessons with carols. This service is open to parents and others, and is followed by one for the school the next morning.
