Dog Policy

Epsom College recognises that the safety of pupils, staff and visitors on site is of paramount importance, and as such the College continues to take precautions to reduce the risks to the health of pupils, staff and visitors which might be associated with dogs on site.

Visitors are discouraged from bringing dogs onto College grounds.

All dogs must be under strict control and on a lead, whilst on College grounds. Fouling is to be avoided, and any excrement cleared away by the owner immediately, bagged and placed in one of the bins on site.

As the majority of the site is used for school teaching/sporting/social activities, we would ask that dogs are not, whenever possible, exercised on the grounds. If this is unavoidable, then visitors are asked to keep their dogs to the perimeter of the site.

The College reserves the right to ask any visitor to leave the school grounds, if unwilling to keep to these rules.
