EPSOM The Mermaid A Centre for Excellence

Epsom is experiencing an exceptional period of popularity, growth and success. Between 2016-19 the total number of registered applicants has risen by 64%; by way of detail, applications at 11+ have risen by 96% and at 13+ by 45%. In 2019, the total school enrolment stood at 952 and this has risen to 1,023 pupils in 2020-21.

At A-level, the College has advanced through The Telegraph Schools League Tables: 2017 - 87th, 2018 - 73rd, 2019 - 43rd. The Good Schools Guide 2019 attests to the fact that Epsom is 'a school that's really going places'. The College is seeking to harness this period of advancement further to improve our pupils' education and future prospects by building a new Centre for Excellence.

Towards this end, the Governors have appointed architects to fashion an exceptional 2,000 sq m new building at the heart of the College. The Mermaid is poised to be one of the largest developments that the College has undertaken; the timing is propitious for us to transform our pupils' educational experience.

Located on the site of the former Tuck Shop and College Stores, The Mermaid will include a lecture theatre, classrooms, learning pods, a gallery and café, and cinema screening room, enabling us to continue to deliver an exceptional learning experience across many disciplines, in state-of-the-art facilities.

Planning permission has been granted and building works commenced in the summer of 2020; however, further financial resources are required to enable us to make more progress.



Built on the footprint of the current Sixth Form Centre, located at the heart of the campus, and spread over almost 2,000 sq.m, the building will transform the educational experience of all our pupils and equip them with the skills to succeed in the 21st century.

This exciting multi-dimensional building will facilitate social and academic interaction between all pupils, enabling specialist careers guidance, and be the central venue for our rich and diverse cultural activities.

Our vision is unique. There is no other coeducational school that combines academic excellence, careers, social and cultural exchange into one area in such a compelling fashion.

This transformative space will be built across three floors and designed in a Victorian contemporary style to complement the other buildings in the Quad.

FOSTERING ACADEMIC **EXCELLENCE**

Leading universities and top employers look for students who are skilled at both collaborative and independent learning. The building will facilitate both modes of learning; providing Pods for group discussions and a large Study Room for private study. The facilities will enable pupils to embark upon exciting collaborative tasks and projects, and learn in an environment that fosters intellectual discussion. It will, in fact, rival the provision at world-leading universities, producing well-prepared and confident students who excel academically.

The House system remains central to Epsom College, but there is a need for this provision to be complemented by a co-educational space that further enriches the pupils' total educational experience.

There is currently no central area in which all our Sixth Form students may come together, learn from each other, and prepare for university. The Mermaid will fulfil this vision
