Assessment

Paper 1

You will tackle data response and essay questions on marketing, people and global businesses – this is the content you study in Theme 1 and Theme 4.

Paper 2

You will tackle data response and essay questions on business activities, decisions and strategy – this is the content you study in Theme 2 and Theme 3.

Paper 3

You will have a research task before the exam.

The questions in the exam

– data response and essay questions – are linked to the context you will research.

Majority of questions require extended written responses

Paper 3 is synoptic, with a pre-released theme 2023: The UK car market


Subjects have some content overlap, for instance:
